 **Solution:**

X is father of Y and Y is sister of Z → same parent → X is father of Z.

 **Shortcut:**

Father of Sibling = **Father**

👉 **Solution:**

If A is son of B and C is wife of B \rightarrow C is mother.

⚡ **Shortcut:**

Wife of Father = **Mother**

Q \rightarrow mother of P

For SSC GD style, brother of father = uncle — here context: A is brother of C 's husband = brother-in-law (treated as uncle if addressing child).

⚡ **Shortcut:** Track relation stepwise: B related to C , then A related to B .

(Exam tip: when questions map to family generation, interpret as uncle if asked “how is A related to C ?” in simple family tree contexts.)*
