**Rules + Explanation (Complete Guide)**

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### **● RULE 1: Subject–Verb Agreement**

**Rule:**

- Singular subject → singular verb
- Plural subject → plural verb
- *Each / Everyone / One of* → **Singular verb**

**PYQ Examples**

✗ *He do not know the answer.*  
 ✓ **He does not know the answer.**

👉 (Q1 – Error in **do**)

✗ *Each of the boys were given a prize.*  
 ✓ **Each of the boys was given a prize.**

👉 (Q5)

✗ *One of my friends are a doctor.*  
 ✓ **One of my friends is a doctor.**

👉 (Q10)

### ● RULE 2: Helping Verb after “Did / Does / Do”

Rule:

- After **did / does / do** → Verb always in base form (V<sup>1</sup>)

**PYQ Examples**

✗ *She didn't went there.*  
 ✓ **She didn't go there.**

👉 (Q6)

✗ *She doesn't knows anything.*  
 ✓ **She doesn't know anything.**

👉 (Q25)

### ● RULE 3: Present Perfect Tense

Rule:

- Structure → **has/have + V<sup>3</sup>**
- ✗ **Never use V<sup>2</sup>**
- ✗ **Never use past time (yesterday, ago)**

**PYQ Examples**

✗ *He has went home.*  
 ✓ **He has gone home.**

👉 (Q7)

✗ *I have finished my work yesterday.*  
 ✓ **I finished my work yesterday.**

👉 (Q18)

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#### ● RULE 4: Stative Verbs (Like, Know, Believe, Love)

Rule:

- Stative verbs **never** used in **Continuous tense**

**PYQ Examples**

✗ *I am knowing him.*

✓ **I know him.**

👉 (Q4)

✗ *He is liking coffee.*

✓ **He likes coffee.**

👉 (Q9)

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#### ● RULE 5: Along with / As well as / Together with

Rule:

- Verb agrees with **first subject**, not the second

**PYQ Example**

✗ *The teacher along with students are present.*

✓ **The teacher along with students is present.**

👉 (Q8)

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#### ● RULE 6: Degrees of Comparison

Rule:

- Never use **double comparison**

**PYQ Examples**

✗ *She is more better than you.*

✓ **She is better than you.**

👉 (Q20)

✗ *He is senior than me.*

✓ **He is senior to me.**

👉 (Q19)

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#### ● RULE 7: Since / For

Rule:

- Since → point of time
- For → period of time

#### PYQ Examples

✗ *She was absent since Monday.*  
 ✓ **She has been absent since Monday.**  
 ➤ (Q44)

✗ *She has been waiting from morning.*  
 ✓ **She has been waiting since morning.**  
 ➤ (Q48)

#### ● RULE 8: Correct Prepositions

Word	Correct Preposition
fond	of
angry	with
married	to
good	at
afraid	of
junior/senior	to
insist	on

#### PYQ Examples

✗ *He is fond to music.*  
 ✓ **He is fond of music.**  
 ➤ (Q28)

✗ *He is married with her.*  
 ✓ **He is married to her.**  
 ➤ (Q30)

#### ● RULE 9: No + Any (Double Negative)

Rule:

- ✗ Never use two negatives together

#### PYQ Example

✗ *She has no any money.*  
✓ **She has no money / She doesn't have any money.**  
👉 (Q37)

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### ● RULE 10: Hard vs Hardly

Rule:

- Hard = intensely
- Hardly = scarcely (almost not)

PYQ Example

✗ *She works hardly for success.*  
✓ **She works hard for success.**  
👉 (Q39)

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### ● RULE 11: Passive Voice Structure

Rule:

- Passive = **Helping verb + V<sup>3</sup>**

PYQ Examples

✗ *The letter is being wrote.*  
✓ **The letter is being written.**  
👉 (Q54)

✗ *The cake was ate by him.*  
✓ **The cake was eaten by him.**  
👉 (Q72)

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### ● RULE 12: Reported Speech (Tense Change)

Rule:

- Present → Past
- Will → Would
- Is → Was
- Has → Had

PYQ Examples

✗ *He said that he will come next day.*  
✓ **He said that he would come the next day.**  
👉 (Q52)

✗ *She said that she will help me.*  
✓ **She said that she would help me.**  
👉 (Q67)

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### ● RULE 13: Indirect Questions

Rule:

- ✗ No helping verb
- ✗ No question order

PYQ Examples

✗ *She asked me where was I going.*  
✓ **She asked me where I was going.**  
👉 (Q53)

✗ *He asked me where did I live.*  
✓ **He asked me where I lived.**  
👉 (Q75)

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### ● RULE 14: Uncountable Nouns

Rule:

- News, Furniture, Advice → **Singular**

PYQ Example

✗ *The news were shocking.*  
✓ **The news was shocking.**  
👉 (Q13)

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### ● RULE 15: Spread – Spread – Spread

Rule:

- ✗ No “spreaded”

PYQ Example

✗ *The news was spreaded fast.*  
✓ **The news was spread fast.**  
👉 (Q90)

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 EXAM FINAL SHORTCUT

- ✓ Did → V<sup>1</sup>
- ✓ Has/Have → V<sup>3</sup>
- ✓ Each / Everyone → Singular verb
- ✓ Since = point | For = period
- ✓ Passive = Helping + V<sup>3</sup>
- ✓ Reported speech → tense shift
